

Smoke

The following pages are all the verses in the Bible that have the word “SMOKE” in them. Many SDA’s have come to the false understanding of Revelation 9: 2-3, thinking that the word “SMOKE” means a cloud of errors. When you look at the following passages of KJV Scripture you will see that “SMOKE” means just the opposite in most verses. Example, Psalms 74:1 it says “O God, why hast thou cast [us] off for ever? [why] doth thine anger smoke against the sheep of thy pasture?” You will notice that “SMOKE” means God’s anger against His people for sin and this is just what the church at Rome had done by 538AD, they had sinned against God.

Still the patriarch begged for some visible token as a confirmation of his faith and as an evidence to after-generations that God's gracious purposes toward them would be accomplished. The Lord condescended to enter into a covenant with His servant, employing such forms as were customary among men for the ratification of a solemn engagement. By divine direction, Abraham sacrificed a heifer, a she-goat, and a ram, each three years old, dividing the bodies and laying the pieces a little distance apart. To these he added a turtledove and a young pigeon, which, however, were not divided. This being done, he reverently passed between the parts of the sacrifice, making a solemn vow to God of perpetual obedience. Watchful and steadfast, he remained beside the carcasses till the going down of the sun, to guard them from being defiled or devoured by birds of prey. About sunset he sank into a deep sleep; and, "lo, a horror of great darkness fell upon him." And the voice of God was heard, bidding him not to expect immediate possession of the Promised Land, and pointing forward to the sufferings of his posterity before their establishment in Canaan. The plan of redemption was here opened to him, in the death of Christ, the great sacrifice, and His coming in glory. Abraham saw also the earth restored to its Eden beauty, to be given him for an everlasting possession, as the final and complete fulfillment of the promise. {PP 137.1}

As a pledge of this covenant of God with men, a smoking furnace and a burning lamp, symbols of the divine presence, passed between the severed victims, totally consuming them. And again a voice was heard by Abraham, confirming the gift of the land of Canaan to his descendants, "from the river of Egypt unto the great river, the river Euphrates." {PP 137.2}

Genesis 9:26-28 But his wife looked back from behind him, and she became a pillar of salt. [27] And Abraham gat up early in the morning to the place where he stood before the LORD: [28] And he looked toward Sodom and Gomorrah, and toward all the land of the plain, and beheld, and, lo, **the smoke** of the country went up as **the smoke** of a furnace. *Smoke was the result of the wrath of God.*

Exodus 19:18 And mount Sinai was altogether **on a smoke**, because the LORD descended upon it in fire: and **the smoke** thereof ascended as **the smoke** of a furnace, and the whole mount quaked greatly. *Smoke was the presence of God.*

Deuteronomy 29:20 The LORD will not spare him, but then the anger of the LORD and his jealousy **shall smoke against that man**, and all the curses that are written in this book shall lie upon him, and the LORD shall blot out his name from under heaven. *Smoke was God's anger.*

Joshua 8:20, 21 And when the men of Ai looked behind them, they saw, and, behold, the **smoke of the city ascended up to heaven**, and they had no power to flee this way or that way: and the people that fled to the wilderness turned back upon the pursuers. [21] And when Joshua and all Israel saw that the ambush had taken the city, and that **the smoke of the city ascended**, then they turned again, and slew the men of Ai. *Smoke is literal smoke of fire.*

Judges 20:38-40 Now there was an appointed sign between the men of Israel and the liars in wait, that they should make a **great flame with smoke** rise up out of the city. [39] And when the men of Israel retired in the battle, Benjamin began to smite [and] kill of the men of Israel about thirty persons: for they said, Surely they are smitten down before us, as [in] the first battle. [40] But when the **flame began to arise up out of the city with a pillar of smoke**, the Benjamites looked behind them, and, behold, the flame of the city ascended up to heaven. *Smoke is literal smoke of fire.*

2 Samuel 22:7-15 In my distress I called upon the LORD, and cried to my God: and he did hear my voice out of his temple, and my cry [did enter] into his ears. [8] Then the earth shook and trembled; the foundations of heaven moved and shook, because he was wroth. [9] **There went up a smoke out of his nostrils, and fire out of his mouth devoured: coals were kindled by it.** [10] He bowed the heavens also, and came down; and darkness [was] under his feet. [11] And he rode upon a cherub, and did fly: and he was seen upon the wings of the wind. [12] And he made darkness pavilions round about him, dark waters, [and] thick clouds of the skies. [13] Through the brightness before him were coals of fire kindled. [14] The LORD thundered from heaven, and the most High uttered his voice. [15] And he sent out arrows, and scattered them; lightning, and discomfited them. *Smoke was God's anger.*

Job 41:19-21 Out of his mouth go burning lamps, [and] sparks of fire leap out. [20] **Out of his nostrils goeth smoke,** as [out] of a seething pot or caldron. [21] His breath kindleth coals, and a flame goeth out of his mouth. *Smoke is a symbol of God power.*

Psalms 18:7-9 Then the earth shook and trembled; the foundations also of the hills moved and were shaken, because he was wroth. [8] **There went up a smoke out of his nostrils, and fire out of his mouth devoured:** coals were kindled by it. [9] He bowed the heavens also, and came down: and darkness [was] under his feet. *Smoke is the power of God.*

Psalms 37:18-21 The LORD knoweth the days of the upright: and their inheritance shall be for ever. [19] They shall not be ashamed in the evil time: and in the days of famine they shall be satisfied. [20] But the wicked shall perish, and the enemies of the LORD [shall be] as the fat of lambs: **they shall consume; into smoke shall they consume away.** [21] The wicked borroweth, and payeth not again: but the righteous showeth mercy, and giveth. *Smoke means what will happen to wicked at the end of time.*

Psalms 68:1, 2 To the chief Musician, A Psalm [or] Song of David. Let God arise, let his enemies be scattered: let them also that hate him flee before him. [2] **As smoke is driven away,** [so] drive [them] away: as wax melteth before the fire, [so] let the wicked perish at the presence of God. *Smoke means sin will be driven away like smoke.*

Psalms 74:1 O God, why hast thou cast [us] off for ever? **[why] doth thine anger smoke against the sheep of thy pasture?** *Smoke means God's anger.*

Psalms 102:3 **For my days are consumed like smoke,** and my bones are burned as an hearth. *Smoke means like the quick disappearance of smoke in regards to length of life.*

Psalms 104:31, 32 The glory of the LORD shall endure for ever: the LORD shall rejoice in his works. [32] He looketh on the earth, and it trembleth: **he toucheth the hills, and they smoke.** *Smoke means God's power.*

Psalms 119:82-84 Mine eyes fail for thy word, saying, When wilt thou comfort me? [83] **For I am become like a bottle in the smoke;** [yet] do I not forget thy statutes. [84] How many [are] the days of thy servant? when wilt thou execute judgment on them that persecute me? *Smoke here means cloudy.*

Psalms 144:5 Bow thy heavens, O LORD, and come down: **touch the mountains, and they shall smoke.** *Smoke here means God's power.*

Proverbs 10:26 As vinegar to the teeth, and **as smoke to the eyes,** so [is] the sluggard to them that send him. *Smoke here means an irritant.*

Song of Solomon 3:5-7 I charge you, O ye daughters of Jerusalem, by the roes, and by the hinds of the field, that ye stir not up, nor awake [my] love, till he please. [6] **Who [is] this that cometh out of the wilderness like pillars of smoke,** perfumed with myrrh and frankincense, with all powders of the merchant? [7] Behold his bed, which [is] Solomon's; threescore valiant men [are] about it, of the valiant of Israel. *Smoke means power of God.*

Isaiah 4:5 And the LORD will create upon every dwelling place of mount Zion, and upon her assemblies, **a cloud and smoke by day,** and the shining of a flaming fire by night: for upon all the glory [shall be] a defence. *Smoke is the power of God as a guide.*

Isaiah 6:3-5 And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, [is] the LORD of hosts: the whole earth [is] full of his glory. [4] And the posts of the door moved at the voice of him that cried, **and the house was filled with smoke.** [5] Then said I, Woe [is] me! for I am undone; because I [am] a man of

unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips: for mine eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts. Smoke means the power of God presence.

Isaiah 9:17-19 Therefore the Lord shall have no joy in their young men, neither shall have mercy on their fatherless and widows: for every one [is] an hypocrite and an evildoer, and every mouth speaketh folly. For all this his anger is not turned away, but his hand [is] stretched out still. [18] For wickedness burneth as the fire: it shall devour the briars and thorns, and shall kindle in the thickets of the forest, **and they shall mount up [like] the lifting up of smoke.** [19] Through the wrath of the LORD of hosts is the land darkened, and the people shall be as the fuel of the fire: no man shall spare his brother. Smoke means disappearance.

Isaiah 14:31 Howl, O gate; cry, O city; thou, whole Palestina, [art] dissolved: **for there shall come from the north a smoke**, and none [shall be] alone in his appointed times. Smoke means disappearance.

Isaiah 34:10 It shall not be quenched night nor day; **the smoke thereof shall go up for ever**: from generation to generation it shall lie waste; none shall pass through it for ever and ever. Smoke means continuing vapor or disappearance.

Isaiah 51:6 Lift up your eyes to the heavens, and look upon the earth beneath: **for the heavens shall vanish away like smoke**, and the earth shall wax old like a garment, and they that dwell therein shall die in like manner: but my salvation shall be for ever, and my righteousness shall not be abolished. Smoke means disappearance, but God's salvation lasts forever.

Isaiah 65:4 Which remain among the graves, and lodge in the monuments, which eat swine's flesh, and broth of abominable [things is in] their vessels; [5] Which say, Stand by thyself, come not near to me; for I am holier than thou. **These [are] a smoke in my nose, a fire that burneth all the day.** [6] Behold, [it is] written before me: I will not keep silence, but will recompense, even recompense into their bosom. Smoke means God's anger.

Hosea 13:3 Therefore they shall be as the morning cloud, and as the early dew that passeth away, as the chaff [that] is driven with the whirlwind out of the floor, **and as the smoke out of the chimney.** Smoke means disappearance.

Joel 2:30 And I will show wonders in the heavens and in the earth, blood, and fire, **and pillars of smoke.** Smoke means God's power.

Nahum 2:13 Behold, I [am] against thee, saith the LORD of hosts, and **I will burn her chariots in the smoke**, and the sword shall devour thy young lions: and I will cut off thy prey from the earth, and the voice of thy messengers shall no more be heard. Smoke means results of God's wrath.

Acts 2:19 And I will show wonders in heaven above, and signs in the earth beneath; blood, and fire, and **vapour of smoke**: Smoke; shows God's power in the smoke.

Revelation 8:3 And another angel came and stood at the altar, having a golden censer; and there was given unto him much incense, that he should offer [it] with the prayers of all saints upon the golden altar which was before the throne. [4] **And the smoke of the incense**, [which came] with the prayers of the saints, ascended up before God out of the angel's hand. [5] And the angel took the censer, and filled it with fire of the altar, and cast [it] into the earth: and there were voices, and thunderings, and lightnings, and an earthquake. Smoke represents prayers from the censer going to Heaven.

Revelation 9:1-3 And the fifth angel sounded, and I saw a star fall from heaven unto the earth: and to him was given the key of the bottomless pit. [2] And he opened the bottomless pit; and **there arose a smoke** out of the pit, **as the smoke of a great furnace**; and the sun and the air **were darkened by reason of the smoke of the pit.** [3] **And there came out of the smoke** locusts upon the earth: and unto them was given power, as the scorpions of the earth have power. Smoke means God's anger with the new Roman apostasy of 1260

Revelation 9:17 And thus I saw the horses in the vision, and them that sat on them, having breastplates of fire, and of jacinth, and brimstone: and the heads of the horses [were] as the heads of lions; **and out of their mouths issued fire and smoke** and brimstone. [18] By these three **was the third part of men killed, by the fire, and by the smoke**, and by the brimstone, which issued out of their mouths. Smoke means vengeance of God or power of God.

Revelation 14:11 And **the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever**: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receiveth the mark of his name. Smoke means forever till it is gone.

Revelation 15:8 And **the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God**, and from his power; and no man was able to enter into the temple, till the seven plagues of the seven angels were fulfilled. Smoke is from the power of God's presence.

Revelation 18:9 And the kings of the earth, who have committed fornication and lived deliciously with her, shall bewail her, and lament for her, **when they shall see the smoke of her burning**, [10] Standing afar off for the fear of her torment, saying, Alas, alas that great city Babylon, that mighty city! for in one hour is thy judgment come. Smoke shows what will happen at the time of the destruction of the Beast.

Revelation 18:18 **And cried when they saw the smoke of her burning**, saying, What [city is] like unto this great city! Smoke shows what will happen at the time of the destruction of the Beast.

Revelation 19:3 And again they said, Alleluia. And **her smoke rose up for ever and ever**. Smoke shows what will happen at the time of the destruction of the Beast.
